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SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

The Victoria School is a PK-11 private, co-educational, non-sectarian institution. It was founded twenty one years ago by a Colombian entrepreneur as an **International Baccalaureate (IB) school**. The Victoria School offers three IB programs: The Diploma Programme (DP), for students in 10th and 11th grade; the Middle Years Programme (MYP), for students in 5th to 9th grade and the Primary Years Program (PYP), for students in PK to 4th grade. In Preschool we are inspired in the Reggio Emilia philosophy within the framework of the PYP. This continuum of international education allows us to prepare our students to face the challenges of demanding university programs in the country and abroad.

The academic year begins the second week of August and finishes at the end of June.

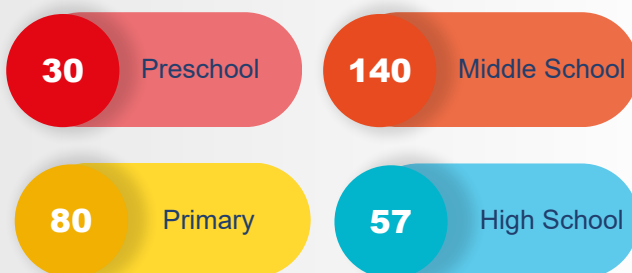
Vision

The Diploma Programme:

The Diploma Program (DP) is a two-year program (grades 10 & 11 Colombian nomenclature, 11& 12 US nomenclature) in which students have the opportunity to demonstrate their academic achievements comparable to international schools across the world. Our students organize every year TVS MUN and participate in local and international UN Models.

Grading System

At Victoria School, all students in grades 10 and 11 are automatically enrolled as candidates for the Diploma Programme. The evaluation objectives for each subject during the period are detailed, and graded on a scale of 1 to 7, according to the achievement levels set by the International Baccalaureate. It is important to note that Victoria School does not engage in any type of student ranking or classification, and instead places emphasis on individual student growth and development.
